This Library Memo announces the release and availability of "Sperry Univac<sup>®</sup> 90/25, 90/30 and 90/40 Data Processing Systems Documentation Configuration Chart", UP-8211 Rev. 3. This chart is a Standard Library Item (SLI).

This revision of the documentation configuration chart illustrates the publications available to support the various hardware and software components of the SPERRY UNIVAC 90/25, 90/30, and 90/40 Data Processing Systems as of July 1979. The new publications added to this chart are shaded. The types of publications referenced on this chart include:

- Component Description (CD) Manuals

These manuals are provisional in nature and are intended to introduce a hardware component or subsystem.

- Functional Description (FD) Manuals

These manuals are technical in nature and serve to describe the functional characteristics of a hardware component or subsystem.

- General Description (GD) and General Information (GI) Manuals

These manuals are intended primarily as marketing aids. They provide an overview of their subjects. The system description manual is one of the publications in this category.

- Introduction Manuals (IM)

These manuals provide an introductory overview of a particular system concept or software element. They are intended for users who wish to understand the purpose and capabilities of a system without having to delve into its operation. These documents also serve as marketing aids.

- Reference Manuals

Manuals of this type include programmer reference (PR), operator reference (OR), subsystem reference (SR), and supplementary reference (SUPPL) manuals. These manuals are intended to be used as quick-reference manuals by both system operators and programmers.

- **Summaries (S)**

These manuals, booklets, or cards, summarize reference materials concerning instruction codes, statement formats, etc., in tabular format.

- **User Guides (UG)**

These manuals provide detailed information concerning the use and capabilities of their subjects.

- **Media and Expendable Supplies (MS)**

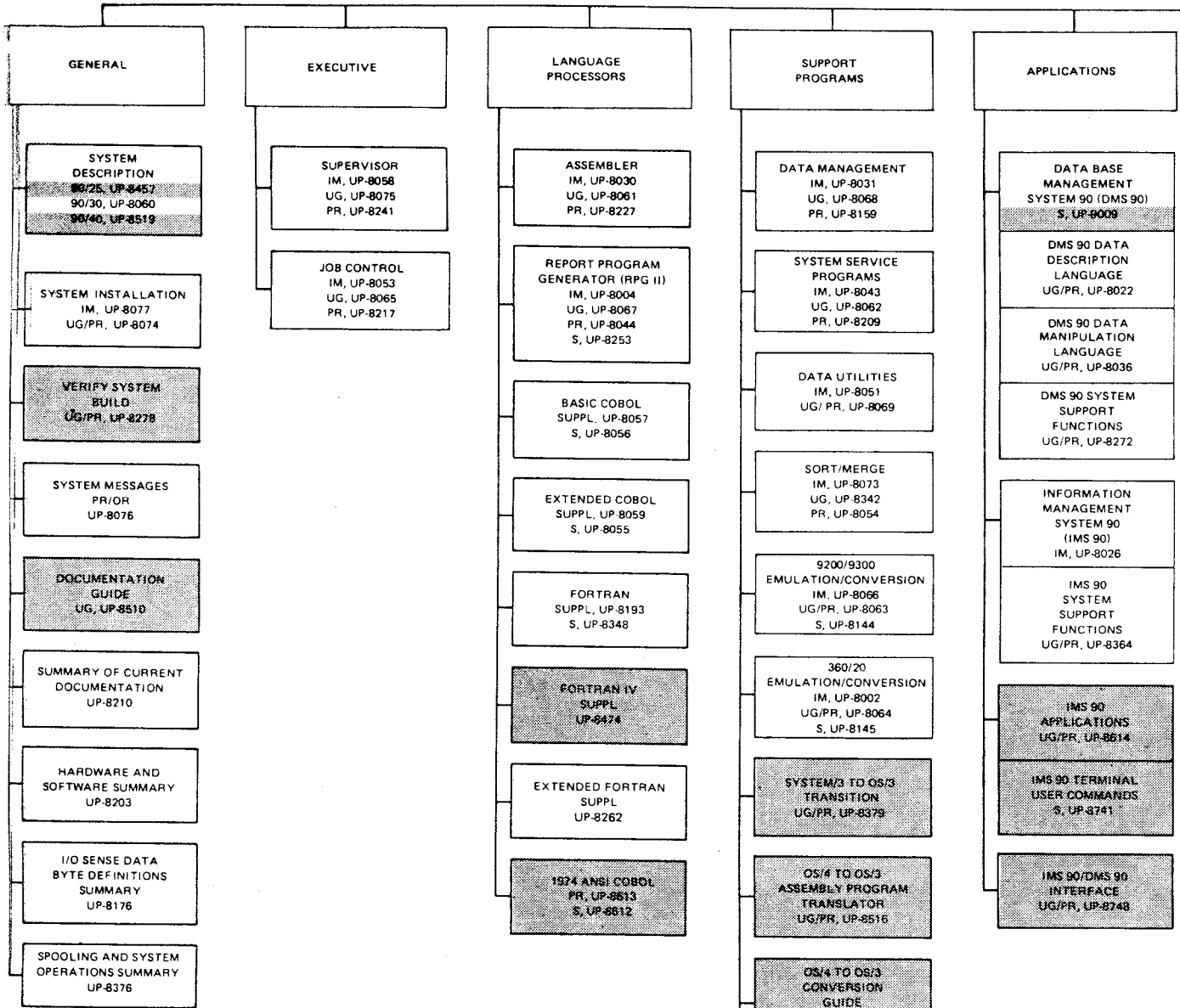
These manuals guide the user in purchasing operating media (magnetic tape, disc packs, etc.) and/or expendable supplies (paper, ribbon, etc.) required for operation of a peripheral device or subsystem.

- **Operator Guides (OG)**

These manuals guide the operator in the use and operation of a peripheral device or subsystem.
