

**NAME**

CURLOPT\_PROXYUSERNAME – user name to use for proxy authentication

**SYNOPSIS**

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_PROXYUSERNAME,  
                           char *username);
```

**DESCRIPTION**

Pass a char \* as parameter, which should be pointing to the zero terminated user name to use for the transfer.

*CURLOPT\_PROXYUSERNAME(3)* sets the user name to be used in protocol authentication with the proxy.

To specify the proxy password use the *CURLOPT\_PROXYPASSWORD(3)*.
